Dog Beach!!! Del Mar's famous dog beach is just minutes away. Drive west on Via De La Valle til you get to the Pacific Coast Highway, turn left. Park wherever you can as soon as you turn onto PCH. It is paid parking, you'll need a credit card or cash to pay. If parking is full before you cross the bridge, just keep heading south until you find a spot. You will want to back track over the bridge (go back north) to get to the main dog beach. It is recommended to check the tides and go at low tide, which means more room, especially since its a weekend. If the tide is low

enough, when you get to the ocean head north around the corner for less activity. Please watch for signs as you head further north. Once you cross the border into Solana Beach, dogs must be back on leash. Have fun!
